W. McDonald and R. M. McDonald being the same piece sold by A. D. Duncan assignee to Geo. W. Duson and others together with all the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to him to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said John B. Marshall his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John B. D. 1889 Between Robert L. Davenport on one part and Isaac M. McCullough (called) on the second part witnesseth (1) That the said Robert L.

McCullough his Executors Administrators and assigns to be kept performed and paid as herein after mentioned Have Rented Let and Leased and by these presents do rent Let and Lease unto the said Isaac M. McCullough all that Tract of land consisting of Eighty acres and known as the Frankley Davenport place and bounded by lands of Obediah Davenport and the son Allison Comstock Jane Chandler and other lands belonging to the said Robt L. Davenport To have and to hold the said premises and tract of land unto the said Isaac McCullough for during the term of three years next beginning on the first day of January next and containing in full force for the next three years provided that the just and full and yearly rents and paid as they become due and all the covenants kept and fully complied with Then this agreement is in full force and virtue as above mentioned otherwise they will be null and void and of no effect (4th) And the said Isaac M. McCullough for himself his heirs Executors and administrators doth covenant promise and agree to and with the said Robert L. Davenport his Executors Administrators or assigns the first and full sum and amount of two Thousand four hundred of good middling lint cotton yearly to be paid on or before the first day of each November for the said three years above mentioned it is also agreed on by the said Isaac M. McCullough that all the crop crops and part of crops grown on said lands shall be bound unto the said Robt L. Davenport and he shall have a prior lien on all said crops until said Rent are paid in full (5) It is also further agreed on by the said Isaac M. McCullough to keep the said premises and pasture in good repair and to ditch said land and prevent it from washing as far as is in his power to prevent the said waters wheresoever they may be to the above presents do hereto set our hands and seals this the 13th day of August A.
