Ansel Nesbitt This agreement made this 5th day of November A. D. 1889 between Elizabeth M. Heyward of the one part and Ansel Nesbitt of the other part witnesseth that the said Elizabeth M. Heyward hereby agrees for herself her heirs and assigns (in consideration of the payments and conditions herein after set forth and when the conditions hereinafter set forth shall have been fully complied with by the said Ansel Nesbitt) to convey to the said Ansel Nesbitt or his heirs by quiet claim deed all that piece of land or lot of land situate in the City of Greenville County of Greenville State of South Carolina on University Street in said city adjoining the lot upon which the Greenville Hotel now stands this being the lot bought by the said Elizabeth M. Heyward from L. L. This indenture made the twenty fourth day of August A. D. 1889 witnesseth that the Camperdown Cotton Mills a corporation duly chartered and doing business at Greenville in said state for the consideration hereinafter mentioned have granted devised and leased and by these presents do grant devise and lease unto Robert E. Allen and Hollingsworth M. Gowen of the same place all that certain piece of land or lot of land situate lying and being in said county and state on Rudy River just above the lower bridge containing by estimation about two and one half acres and having the following lines and bounds to wit Beginning at an iron pin in W. C. Cleveland's corner and running thence N 75 E 2 c 70 l to a iron pin near the bridge thence N 70 E 63 to an iron pin (brick or gone) thence N 4 1/2 E 150 to an iron pin (white oak gone) thence N 4 1/2 W 365 to a stake near a white oak n. m. thence down the south side of the river to said Cleveland's line thence across the river to the beginning together with the old saw mill shoal and the waterhouse now called is known as the lower bridge for the purpose of constructing a new mill and carrying a great mill and works to be built
