Dated 4th day of June 1890 by these presents
That I Lewis W. Parker of Greenville
County, for and in Consideration of the sum of Five Hundred
and Fifty Dollars to me in Hand paid at and before
the sealing of these presents by John A. Russell, in the
state aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
ed.) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the
said John A. Russell, all that lot or parcel of land situated
in Greenville City, State and County aforesaid, and lying
out the West side of Main St church, beginning at an iron
state on the corner of Garrison's land and running with said
party line S 70° 45' E 200 feet to an iron state on an alley or lan
chance with said line N 18° 12' E 67 feet to an iron state, then
N 70° 45' E to an iron state on Main St. said line being 200 ft.
thence with and on said line N 67 ft S 19° E to the beginning corner
said lot being a part of an acre conveyed to me by South
Baptist Theological Seminary and being bounded by land
of Mrs. Garrison and myself. Said lot is marked as lot
#1 on a plat of said acre made for me by J. D. Trotter
Surveyor, reference being there to made as a part of the
deed. Together with all and singular the Rights, members
Herdiments and appurtenances to the said premises belong
ing, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and
to hold all and singular the said premises before men
tioned unto the said John A. Russell his heirs and assigns
forever. And in Consideration of the sum above mentioned
and the further sum of Five Dollars to me in Hand
paid, I do hereby grant and sell and convey unto the
John A. Russell his heirs and assigns the use of and right
of way over a line as hereinafter mentioned, lying
commencing on Main St. at the corner of Lester's lot and
running with a width of nine feet through to Townes St.
over a lane commencing on said lane 206 feet from Main
St. and the same distance from Townes St. and running no
way between the two to Mrs. Garrison's line, with a width of
Thirty feet through it said course or way being for the purpose
of giving a ready access to the rear of the lot sold by me to
the said John A. Russell, and being conditional upon the
payment by the said John A. Russell, and his assigns
of one tenth of all such expenses as may be incurred in
keeping the said lane open and free from obstruction.

duration and the said right of way to last only during such time as
the above conditions be performed. Said easement to cease and
determine at such time that the said party or parties refuse or
neglect to pay the above expenses the amount thereof to be determined
by the majority of the lots owners on said lands. And I do sue
by bind myself and my heirs, Executors and Administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
premises unto the said John A. Russell his heirs and assigns
against me and my heirs and all other persons whatsoever
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
