The above rents to be paid as the crops are gathered the party of the second part has the option of clearing any lands on the same side of the road the house is on and in case he does so he is to have the same rents free for the first year 5. The parties of the first part further agrees to sell the party of second part the aforesaid premises provided good titles can be made and then in that event the party of the second part agrees to pay fifteen dollars per acre for same on or before the 1st of December A.D. 1890 and if the money is paid by that time of this provision carried out the aforesaid lease in that event to become null & void witness our hands and seals this the 22 day of February A.D. 1890
