on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of April 1880 execute and deliver a mortgage to Dallie M.  
Gower, Helen J. Shumate & P. H. Reilly partners doing business in the  
City of Greenville in the State & County aforesaid under the firm name  
of Gower, Shumate & Reilly said mortgage being executed and delivered  
to them under their said firm name on the lot and parcel of land herein  
after described to secure the payment of a bond or obligation executed  
and delivered to the said Gower, Shumate & Reilly for the sum of two hun-  
dred and seventy five Dollars. which mortgage is recorded in the Regis-  
ters of Meane Conveyances office for said County of Greenville in  
Volume L page 528. said mortgage containing a power of attorney  
to said Gower, Shumate & Reilly authorizing them or their assign  
to sell said lot of land at public auction to the highest bidder if said  
debt should not be paid when due and authorizing them or either  
of them to become the purchasers at such sale and whereas said debt  
being due and no part thereof being paid said Gower, Shumate & Reilly  
under said power of attorney and with the written consent of said  
Harriet C. Henderson endorsed on said mortgage did after duly ad-  
vertising said lot of land sell the same at public auction on 1<sup>st</sup>  
day in January 1881 to the highest bidder and said Gower, Shumate  
& Reilly being the highest bidder at said sale became the purchase-  
rs of said lot of land and the said Harriet C. Henderson gave them pos-  
session of the same but no deed to said lot of land has ever been executed  
and delivered to said Gower, Shumate & Reilly and whereas said  
J. Shumate did on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of November 1882 with draft  
of said firm of Gower, Shumate & Reilly and said Dallie M. Gower  
& P. H. Reilly continued to do the business formerly done by the

iver a deed to said Dallie M. Gower and P. H. Reilly conveying to them all  
her right title and interest of every kind in the property of every kind and de-  
scription held and owned by said Gower, Shumate & Reilly among which

recorded in the office of Register of Meane Conveyances for said County in  
book M. N. page 404 the said Dallie M. Gower and P. H. Reilly holding  
said property including said lot of land as copartnership property bel-  
onging to the copartnership of Gower & Reilly and whereas the said P. H.  
Reilly departed this life on the day of 1889 and whereas said  
Dallie M. Gower & P. H. Reilly continued to do business as partners  
under the firm name of Gower & Reilly until the death of said P. H.  
Reilly at the time aforesaid said Dallie M. Gower by his death be-  
ing the survivor of said firm of Gower & Reilly and whereas said P. H.  
Reilly did by his last will and testament give bequeath and devise  
unto Mrs. Amelia L. Reilly all of his property and property in-  
terests and rights of every kind and description and whereas said Am-  
elia L. Reilly did on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of January 1890 execute and  
deliver to said Dallie M. Gower a deed thereby releasing and con-  
veying unto said Dallie M. Gower all of her right title and inter-  
est in the copartnership property of said firm of Gower & Reilly  
which deed is recorded in the Register of Meane Conveyances  
office for said County in Vol. L. D. page 309. Now know  
all men by these presents that I the said Harriet C. Henderson  
in consideration of the premises & facts herein before re-  
cited have granted bargained sold and released and by these pres-  
ents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Dallie M.  
Gower all that lot-parcel and tract of land situate lying & being  
in the County and State aforesaid and on the South side of John  
St within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville and having  
the following nits butts & bounds. Beginning at a stake on  
John St corner of lot formerly owned by T. E. Davis and thence  
with said lot 840 ft 166 ft to a Stake & thence 50 & 91 ft to a  
stake & on cross St thence along & with the said cross St 40 E  
166 ft to stake corner of said John St cross St. thence along  
& north said John St 150 & 91 ft to the beginning corner  
containing fifteen thousand one hundred and six square  
feet more or less. Together with all and singular there-  
ights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises  
belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold  
all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said  
Dallie M. Gower her heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby
