Now therefore know all men by these presents that I D P Verner Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid by virtue of said decree in consideration of the sum of three Dollars to me paid by the said Hattie A Harbin Mattie E Lock William A Harbin Emma L Harbin and Fandy W Harbin the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Hattie A Harbin Mattie E Lock William A Harbin Emma L Harbin and Fandy W Harbin all that tract of land containing sixty eight acres more or less situate in Greenville County and State aforesaid on the south side of Little Rocky creek waters of Emory River bounded by lands of Andrew Jones Amistad Kings Estate and others. Beginning on a rock on ditch thence with the ditch to a rock on ditch 30m thence S 50 E 65° to a rock 34m thence N 1/2 W 1/4 30m to a rock 34m thence S 45 E 22 1/2° to a rock 34m thence N 82 1/2 W 20 1/2° to a rock 34m thence N 45 E 2 1/2° 34m thence down the branch to Little Rock creek 34m thence up the meander of aid creek to the beginning being the same tract conveyed by John T Bramlett to Martha Harbin on the 5th of November 1883 by deed recorded in the R M Office of said county in Book R R page 210 saving and excepting fourteen acres of said tract which was conveyed by Martha Harbin and J T Harbin Executors to John T Bramlett Guardian on the 8th of March 1887 by deed recorded in the R M Office of said county in Book R S page 869. This deed made this 15th day of Dec 1891 By Mrs L C Forrest of Spartanburg County and State of South Carolina of the first part to William Roberson of Greenville County and State of South Carolina of the second part witnesseth That said L C Forrest in consideration of Two hundred dollars to her paid by Wm Roberson the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has bargained and sold her intent and by these presents does bargain sell & convey to said Wm Roberson and his Heirs & assigns a certain tract or parcel of land in Greenville County State of South Carolina adjoining the lands of William Turner and others bounded as follows viz Beginning on a white oak on the North side of Garrison Creek and run west 23° E 62 33 to a pine thence N 12° West 45° to a stake originally an oak thence Northeast 71 30 to a stake in Turners line thence with Turners line S 34° West 29 to a black oak Turners corner thence with Turners line South 5 1/2 East 23 30 to a white oak Turners corner thence to the beginning containing 20 1/2 acres bounded as follows viz Beginning on a white oak
