State of South Carolina approved December 24th 1890 the Trustees
of the Wadsworth Poor School and their successors in office
are authorized and empowered to sell and convey in fee simple
to any person who shall purchase all or any portion of the lands
left by the last will and testament of Thomas Wadsworth
deceased for the support of a poor school in Greenville County
if in this instrument it will be best for the interest of
said school. And whereas it has been determined by said
Trustees that it will be best for the interest of said school
that the lands hereinabove described be sold, and the said
lands being a portion of the land left by the last will
and testament of Thomas Wadsworth deceased, for
the support of a poor school in Greenville County.

Now therefore Know all men by these Presents That
we R G Wallace M B Lewis M M League C G Miller and
W H Workman Trustees of the Wadsworth Poor
School of Greenville County in the State aforesaid for
and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and
five Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing
and delivery of these Presents (the receipt whereof is here
acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and released
and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and release
unto E B Brougham & A B Davis their heirs and assigns
forever all that piece of land or lot of land aforesaid lying
and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid
on head waters of Richland Creek of Reedy River conta-
ining seven acres more or less and hath such
marks bounds &c as follows, viz: Beginning on a stone

N 63° 8' E 55' to a stone 3x6 thence N 45° 4' W 6' to a stone

Emma Simmons and Thos O'Leary and Aaron Carter

creditors and other incumbrances to the said premises
belonging or in anywise incident or pertaining
