GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Henry Briggs all that piece of land situate and lot

land situate and being in the corporate limits of the said City and County aforesaid
State aforesaid at the fork or junction of Augusta and Pendleton Streets, and
having the following number and bounds, that is to say: Beginning at a
stake on Pendleton Street running thence with said street, 66 feet Sixty
feet to a stake, thence \$366. Forty five feet to a stake on Augusta Street
thence along Augusta Street 71 29 3/4 feet, Sixty three feet to a stake thence
