I, Lydia Heightower, of Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, for And in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars, to me to hand paid at and before the sealing of these Presents, by Lydia J. C. Morgan of the County of Greenville in the State (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Charles P. Heightower and his children subject to the conditions hereinafter stated three pieces or parcels of land lying and being situate in Greenville County in the State aforesaid on North Fork of Saluda River, and is part of the tract of land conveyed to me by W.C. Goodwin the 19th August 1874 containing in all three pieces two hundred and fourteen acres more or less as follows, viz.: beginning at a pine tree N 76 W 0.00 chains to a stone & thence N 66 W 10.75 chains to a stone & thence N 37 1/4 E 12.25 chains to a stone & thence N 10 E 44.75 chains to a stone & in S.W. Hedges line thence S 96 E 18.12.00 chains to a stone & thence S 66 E 31.00 chains to a Hickory & thence S 20 E 10.00 chains to the beginning. The second piece beginning at C.L. Heightowers stake at the River in S.W. Hedges line thence down the River to the bridge on Greenville road thence up the road to a stake & C.L. Heightowers & S.W. Hedges & then E 29.8 with S.W. Hedges line to the beginning. The third piece beginning at the bridge thence down the road 14.70 chains to a stone & on the west bank of the road thence S 81.0. 10.80 chains to a stone & thence S 55 W 3.25 chains to a stone & thence N 65 2/3 W 12.40 chains to a stone & on the east bank of the North Fork of Saluda River thence up and with the meanderings of said River to the beginning bounded by lands of C.L. Heightowers, R.P. Goodwin, S.W. Hedges and others.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

Morgan during her lifetime and after her death unto her children, heirs, and assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against all other persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim, the same or any part thereof, except as above reserved.

Heightower of Greenville County in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lydia J. Morgan and her children subject to the conditions hereinafter stated a tract of land lying and being situate in Greenville County in the State aforesaid on North Fork of Saluda River and is part of the land of land conveyed to me by W.C. Goodwin the 19th August 1874 and a piece conveyed to me by B. C. Hawkins containing in all by estimation One Hundred acres more or less as follows, viz.: beginning at a lightwood tree at Battie C. Hawkins corner thence N 28 1/2 E 21.50 to a pine & thence N 76 W 5.00 to a stone & thence N 66 W 10.75 chains to a stone & thence N 57 1/4 W 12.25 to stake in ridge, thence N 10 E 44.75 chains to stone & in S.W. Hedges line thence N 59 W with S.W. Hedges line to North Fork of Saluda River thence down and with the meanderings of said River to the bridge on Greenville road thence down said road N 17.75 chains to a stone & on the west bank of said road thence S 81 W 10.00 chains to stone & thence S 55 W 3.25 chains to a stone & thence N 65 2/3 W 12.40 chains to stone & on East bank of North Fork of Saluda River thence down the meanderings of said river to a stake in Battie C.
