GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Pelham Mill all that certain tract or
parcel of land, situate in Greenville River, in the County and state aforesaid
having the following dimensions and boundaries: Beginning at a water oak 31 chains from Enoree
River on south side, running thence S 64° E 20.37 chains to a stone 30 m. on line now or formerly
of W.H. Smith, thence N 52° E 8.85 chains to a white oak on south bank of said Enoree River, thence thence
S 36° E 15.3 chains to a pine 30 m across said River, thence S 72° E 8.64 chains to a pine Thompson, thence
N 42° E 10.61 chains to a stone 30 m. Pine corner, thence N 68° W 13 chains to a chestnut
on the East Bank of Ballinger's Creek, thence N 65° W 2 chains to a stone 30 m across said creek
on the road leading to Dillards, thence running with said road N 34° W 8.15 chains to a stone 30 m.
thence N 37° W 41.14 chains to a black oak 30 m. thence N 21° W 6.30 chains to a stone 30 m. thence
N 19° W 9.53 chains to a stone 30 m. and so on, thence N 36° W 4.60 chains to a stone 30 m. thence N 52° W
2.5 chains to a stone 30 m. on south side of Enoree River, fifteen feet from the bank, thence west a line
