Dill of said County and State (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said S. J. Dill all those tracts, pieces or parcels of land lying and being situated in said County and State on Meadow Fork creek of much creek waters of South Tyger River. The first tract is part of the Manassa Taylor tract of land conveyed to me by Wm. E. Earle the 13th of March 1877 and T. E. Ward 7th October 1877 containing one hundred and three (103) acres more or less as follows.
