or part of his tract of land situated in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid on Fall Creek, waters of North Saluda River lying on both sides of State Road Beginning on a state chestnut tree thence with 125' to a Red Oak 3x3x0m dead thence N 45 W 20' to a dead chestnut oak thence N 33 W 14' links to a hickory 3x3x0m thence S 48 W 14' 90' to a sourwood 3x3x0m thence with tract No 2 N 55 W 15' to a hickimon on the east side of the Road Alfred Ward's corner thence to the old Road leading from H. Morgan's old Place thence with said Road to the turn of said Road 18' 60' thence S 40 E 7' 95' to a red oak 3x3x0m down thence East 32' 20' crossing the State Road and creek to the Beginning corner containing fifty acres more or less bounded on the North by lands of Alfred Ward on South by W.
