Monnan all that certain piece of land

and tract situate lying and being in the county of Greenville in the state aforesaid. Beginning on a stone $\frac{1}{2}$ in the road leading to the bottom from the old Elbert Hawkins houseplace and running thence $\frac{1}{2}$ S 7 E 15.5 rods to a stone $\frac{1}{2}$ m from thence N 53 1/2 W 21.35 rods to a stone $\frac{1}{2}$ m thence N 20 E 100 rods to a stone $\frac{1}{2}$ m formerly a red oak. Thence N 21 1/2 W 104.75 rods to a white oak $\frac{1}{2}$ m from thence S 64 E 29.66 rods to a stone $\frac{1}{2}$ m from thence N 68 1/2 E 15.5 rods to a stone $\frac{1}{2}$ m from thence S 72 1/2 E 7.22 rods to a stone $\frac{1}{2}$ m from thence S 57 1/2 E 13.27 rods to a stone $\frac{1}{2}$ m from thence N 48 E 14.3 rods to a bay laurene on the branch $\frac{1}{2}$ m.
