Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing
of these Presents, by *Mrs. Flatte J. Latimer of the same place*
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO
GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Mrs. Flatte J. Latimer*, all that lot
or parcel of land situate in Ward No. 1 of the city of Greenville in the
County and State aforesaid beginning at a corner of the lot of
Hannah Livingston, on the East side of Mulberry Street, thence thence
S 35° E 10° 24' feet to a corner in West line; thence N 55° E 10° 24' feet along
said West line to a corner on West street; thence along said West
street N 35° W to the corner of said Mulberry and West street; thence
S 55° W along said Mulberry street to the beginning corner and
containing One $\frac{1}{4}$ of an acre more or less & is the same lot to me
conveyed by Charles J. Williamson by deed dated Nov. 8th 1883 in
which the lot is erroneously described as containing 4 of an acre more
or less. This part of the 4 acres deeded by Alex Mcbee Esq. Sept 5th 1870 to William
Cook who on July 15th 1881 conveyed the parcel or lot herein above described to
Charles J. Williamson & he on the day above mentioned conveyed to me.

warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said *Mrs. Flatte J. Latimer & her Heirs and Assigns, against, sale and, my Heirs, and against*
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof,
