City of Greenville and in the County of Greenville State aforesaid on the corner
of College Street and Richard's Creek and containing one & half an acre
more or less said lot has the following lines and bounds: Beginning at a stake 3x on the lot formerly owned by John W.
Stiles, and running thence 673 $\frac{1}{4}$ ft to a stake 3x on Richardson Creek, thence along
said creek 116 $\frac{1}{4}$ ft to a stake 3x on College Street, thence along said street
for 114 ft to a stake 3x, thence 17 $\frac{1}{4}$ ft along the line of the lot above described to the beginning
corner of the same lot that was enjoyed to me by my son-in-law to whom by due date
