Stone Avenue between Front and Hilton Streets, and adjoining
lot A. D. Mr. Dillard and property formerly owned by Interlaken
City Land & Improvement Company and having the following notes and
bounds to wit, Beginning at a rock on the Avenue, just back from off Mr. Dillards lot
