(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Fannie Whitmore, all that piece of land and tract of land containing

Two hundred & forty five acres more or less situate lying & being in the County & State aforesaid in the Western part of Greenville Township on the South side of the Southern Railway, formerly known as the Atlanta & Charlotte Air Line Railroad, & having the following metes & bounds, to wit: Beginning at the Railroad bridge on Saluda river & running thence down the river with its meandering to a stake 31 m in the mouth of a small branch, thence up said branch S 65 1/2 E 10.86 to a poplar 31 m at head of branch, thence S 45 E 25.50 to a stone on a road, thence N 45 E 6.50 to a stone 31 m on said road, thence along the road N 60 W to a bend in road, thence 76 7/4 3/4 E 8.00 to a bend, thence 76 45 E 3.50 to a bend, thence 76 69 E 3.50 to a bend, thence 76 57 E 3.37 to a bend, thence 76 30 1/4 E 2.65 to a bend, thence 76 5 1/2 E 2.62 to a bend, thence 76 1/4 W 6.70 to a bend, thence 76 2 3/4 E 2.50 to a bend, thence 76 17 3/4 E 4.50 to a bend a fork of road leading to house, thence 76 52 1/4 E 2.52 to a bend, thence 76 36 3/4 E 2.21 to a bend, thence 76 5 1/2 E 1.56 to a stone 31 m in the road on the old line Butler Mill race and Furman and Bend Bridge road, thence along said road southwardly to the crossing of said road thence westwardly with the Railroad to the beginning corner at Rail Road Bridge, excluding right of way to the Rail Road.
