(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. G. Judson his heirs and assigns, all that piece of land

or tract of land situated in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, the same as the  
Tanyard Tract near the town of Greenvilles on the Little Creek waters of South Broad  
River, Beginning at a post oak on the Greenville road at the corner of the original Tanyard  
tract and running thence due east three chains to a bunch of Maples on the branch  
thereof 84 chains to a stone, thence N. 64° W. 6.18 chains to a Black oak, thence  
N. 64° E. 3.83 chains to a stone, thence S. 30° E. 0.30 (crossing the creek) 2.80 chains to a stone  
on the R. Alexander line, thence along said line S. 64° W. 7.50 chains to a red oak, thence the  
same direction 13.40 chains to a red oak, thence N. 87° 34' W. 6.18 chains to a Black oak, thence  
N. 64° E. 9.80 chains to a Black oak, thence N. 34° E. 6.80 chains to a stone, thence S. 85° E. 16.50 chains  
to a stone, thence to the beginning (course and distance unknown) containing sixty  
acres more or less, and being the same tract conveyed to me by R. G. Bowden by Deed dated
