Dollars, to Grandson Theodore Stone ... in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by ... by these presents do give, grant, convey, release and confirm unto the said ... have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Theodore Stone all that certain piece parcel or lots of land situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, beginning at a stake on Rutherford Street, next to my lawn and opposite the residence of the late William Burton, and running thence along said street 50 feet to a stake, thence on a line parallel with said street 50 feet to a stake, thence in a straight line 50 feet to the beginning corner, containing four acres, more or less, and bounded on all sides, save the West, by my own lands, and on the west by Rutherford Street.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the said Theodore Stone his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And do hereby bind Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said

Heirs and Assigns, against soever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof. WITNESS my Hand and Seal this 11th day of November A.
