John W. Gaunt,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. S. Gaunt all that tract of land, containing six and one half acres, more or less, situated in the County and State aforesaid, being one-half of the certain farm branch, lying on lands of J. W. Gaunt, said John W. Gaunt, having Mary Green and Robt. Grayson, also one other lot or parcel of land containing four and one-half acres, more or less, situated in the County and State aforesaid, and being one-half of the certain farm branch, lying on lands of Duntas Creek, lying on lands of Robt. Wood. It is understood and said John W. Gaunt, by reason that the consideration of this deed is such that the said J. S. Gaunt shall well and truly pay to me the sum of twenty-five Dollars on the 1st day of December and twenty-five Dollars and each successive 1st day of December thereafter so long as I may live and have to have, so good, quiet and undisturbed possession and land for use and benefit of my family, and his further provided that in the event my wife Penecie Gaunt should outlive me, they shall be entitled to have a decent support in proportion with my other heirs from lands deeded their day.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the said

Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said

J. S. Gaunt, his Heirs and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
