(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John Stalley, the following described land, situated and bounded as follows:

lying and being in Greenville County, S.C., in the road to Rutherford Road, N.C., about 1/2 mile from the said road to Rutherford, comprising 9.14 acres, more or less, and hath such shape, marks and boundaries, as followeth:

To a flat, well made, rocky stone, beginning at a stone at the bridge across road, thence along ditch 8' 11" 8 4/10 to a stone, thence 2 1/11 8 2/10 to a stone, thence 3 4/24 8 4/10 to a stone, thence 8 20 4.11 0.05 to a pine, thence 8 1/2 8 2.68 to a stone and iron pipe, thence 7 1/3 11 8 6.05 to an iron pipe, thence 9 2.81 9.88 to one more pine, thence 7 1/3 11 8 3.75 to a stone on the Rutherford Road 3.35 to another, thence 5 2 3 8 3.45 to another pine, thence 5 6 4/10 3.63 to another pine, thence 10 9.3 10 3.37 to a stone on the Rutherford Road, thence 9 7 5 to a bend, thence 11.5 9 to a bend, thence 9 0 10 8 1/2 the beginning corner, bounded by lands of Eliza Finlay, John Stalley and others.
