S. C. on waters of North Saluda River, bounded by lands of E. Barnett, J. B. Bridwell
Sloan Le Strand and others, it being part of a tract of land bought by Henry J. Strand
of W. G. Tally et al, and is numbered Lot 1203 in the survey and division of said
tract of land made by W. G. Tally for H. J. Strand in Nov 1892, it contains fifty
acres (400) or the same more or less, and runs as follows: viz: - beginning
and a Poplar corner of said H. J. Tally's and runs thence N 47 E 5,000 ft to a stone,
thence S 41 1/4 E 3,250 ft to a stone, thence S 3 1/4 E 14,200 ft to a stone, thence
