 release unto the said W. C. Hillhouse Jr. all that piece of land, situated lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid,  
 and small branch, Waters of Saluda Creek, and on both sides of the old carriage  
 Road, and known as part of the Chestnut Hill place, Beginning at  
 a stone 34. John St. Patricks corner, and running thence N 42° 46' E 14.65 to  
 a stone st. thence N 44 W 9.75 to stone being R. C. D. Dukes line, thence  
 S 87 W 10.80 to stone forming in the center of road, the stone being placed  
 on side of road, on the opposite side, the last line mentioned being  
 Dr. J. P. Ballenger line, and former, thence S 34 E 14.60 to stone 34 the  
 last line being John St. Patricks line, paid to partition property acres
