I James H. Atkinson of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars - 1000.00 Dollars, to me

in hand paid at and before the signing of these presents by J. B. Hughes of the County and State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. B. Hughes, all that certain piece or parcel and tract of land

situate lying and being in the County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, on the south side of Little Rocky Creek, branch waters of Enoree river, Beginning at a stake on said creek, at a ditch junction, thence S 1/4 West 3/4 to stake on ditch thence S 87 1/2 W 2 1/2 to stake on ditch, thence S 1 1/4 W 1 1/2 to stake, thence S 73 W 1 1/2 to stake, thence S 7 1/2 E 1 1/2 to stake, thence N 1 1/4 E 1/2 to stake, thence N 13 1/2 W 3 1/2 to stake, thence N 72 W 10 1/2 to Pine (now oak) 31, thence S 8 E 3 1/2 to oak, on W. Beech & Peckory road, thence up said road S 11 1/2 W 10 1/2 to stake on said road, thence N 6 1/2 E 10 1/2 to Green-wille road thence along road leading to Abner Walker N 11 1/2 E 11 1/2 to stake, thence due North 1/4 to stake, thence North 6 1/4 West 3/4, and 10 links, thence North 7 1/2 E 1/2 to Poplar 31 on said creek, thence down said creek 2 1/2 to the beginning, containing Eighty acres more or less bounded by lands of Abner Walker, J. W. Atkinson, Smith, Starnby being the same tract of land which was conveyed to me by J. Thapron, by deed of conveyance bearing date 15th day of November 1880, (see p. 11)

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said

Heirs and Assigns, against myself and Heirs, and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
