 stake in my corner, thence N 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 28.00 to a stake in my corner,
 thence N 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 30.80 to a stake 34 o.m. in the Chick bridge road;
 thence along the middle of said road as a line 17.46 to the
