in the State aforesaid, for and consideration of the sum of
Dollars, to us and our heirs forever, in consideration of the sum of
inland paid at and before the sealing of these presents by us, do seal and witness that
John Masters & wife Rebbeck Masters, of Greenville County, the State
aforesaid, and especially of Greenville
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
release unto the said J. T. Walker, a tract of land situated in the State
and County aforesaid, and the boundaries are both
sides of a Sliding Rock, and over head waters of Brothers Creek,
Adjoining, and east of J. T. Walker's and John & wife's and others,
Beginning at a stone on the East side of a railway and runs
N. 53° E. 23 chains to a Poplar 31 m. Thence N 35° E. 113.83 to a Chestnut oak on
top of the mountain. Thence N 10° E. 16 to a double Chestnut down, thence
N. 35° E. 33 to a Sp. Oak, down now a gully; thence west passing the
Sliding Gap Rock 45.30 to a Hickory 34 m. thence south crossing
Sliding Creek to a Maple, thence East 80 to the beginning.
(This boundary was to include a tract formerly sold to J. T. Masters)
Containing 600 acres more or less.
