parcel or tract of land, lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid, Beginning on a stone, thence S 31.70 to a stone, thence N 10 E 14.26 to a stone 340m thence N 66 3/4 W 36.75 to stone or to corner of 340m thence S 11 1/2 W 9.20 to P. O. road, thence S 8 E 9.10 to beginning corner, containing Sixty One Half acres (60 1/2) more or less and bounded by lands of Robt Chapman, Jas. Spatt and Wm. Willmore.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
