land described, lying and being in the County of Greenville and State
aforesaid on branch waters off Reedy River, and known as lots No 21
and 22 in W. A. Hudson's Survey for A. C. Jackson Annex, Beginning
on a stone 31 on the street that runs South of the old Charles. J. Hammond St.
house place and running, thence N 46° E 9° 2' to a stone 31, to South End
Avenue, thence N 36 1/2 E 2.45 to bend in street, thence N 31 E 6.50 to bend in
street to a stone 31. thence N 46 E 12.75 to street above referred to. thence with
the street N 46 E 8.45 to the beginning corner. Containing 9 5/8
Nine and five eights of an acre be the same more or less.
