(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Farmers Aid Society all that piece, part and lot of land contain ing Sixteen one hundredth (16/100) of an acre, more or less, situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, in the County and State aforesaid about three and one half miles west of Greenville Court House, near the Southern Railroad on the south side thereof, and having the following measurement and buildings, viz:- Beginning at an iron pin 31 am. corner of the Eliz Church Lot and running thence N 89 E 138 feet to an iron pin 31 am. thence S 13 3/4 E 50 feet to an iron pin 21 m. thence D 89 E 137 feet to an iron pin 24 m. thence N 13 3/4 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner. Bounded north by Eliz Church Lot; west by R. C. Foster's lot; south by Ansel Arnold's lot; east by Mrs. C. A. Mandini lot. And being a part of Lot No. in a plat made by D. L. Shuckel of said Mandins land. And more particularly described by a plat hereto annexed.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
