(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and  
release unto the said William Wilkins all that piece of land  
Containing three  $\frac{1}{4}$  acres, more or less, situate lying and being in  
Greenville County South Carolina, on the middle Fork of Saluda River  
and a small branch thereof, said having the following lines and courses,  
viz. Beginning at a pine 33 ft 24 in., running thence N 49 1/4 W 9.08 to a  
stone 3 ft 6 in. and a Hickory corner, across said river. Hence S 63 1/4 E cross-  
ing the river again 350 ft to a stone 3x4 in., on a branch. Hence the branch with  
its meanders has a line 1100 ft to a stone 3x4 in., on the north east bound-  
ary line of my land. Hence with said line N 60 E 2.00 to the beginning  
pine corner. Adjoining lands of H. B. Brown, said Wilkins and my-  
self, and being a part of a tract of twenty six conveyed to me (then  
Florence D. Howard) by deed from P. S. Gilbreath Sheriff Greenville County
