(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jno. B. Marshall, the following lots of land all of which are situated in the City

of Greenville, County of Greenville State aforesaid, and are described as follows: (1) That lot at the south west corner of Broad and Main Streets in said City, having the following lines and bounds: Beginning at a stone on corner of Main and Broad Streets, running thence N $40^{\circ}30'W$  with Broad Street, one hundred (100) ft. London pine on said street and one on city, twelve feet wide, thence S $14^{\circ}30'E$  with said ally twenty-five (25) feet and seven inches long, thence S $40^{\circ}30'E$  one hundred feet to and from on Main Street, thence N $14^{\circ}30'E$  with Main Street twenty-nine feet seven inches (29 ft 7 in) to beginning former, Together with the right and privilege of using the well of water on the lot adjoining the above described lot. Being same lot conveyed to me on May 1st 1882 by deed of Sarah H. Davison, the same being recorded in R.M.C. Office Book 10, No. 36. (2) also my undivided one half interest in that certain piece of land on west side of Main Street between Jeffries and Broad Street (at corner of lot of Jno. Jeffries) they are now both owned and held by me personally, thence along Broad Street at right angles to Main Street, one hundred & Twenty-five feet, thence in a line due North to Jno. Jeffries, thence along line of Jno. Jeffries in a line parallel to said Jeffries street to point at corner of lot of Jno. Jeffries, thence along line of Jno.
