Twelve Hundred & twenty Five 00/00 Dollars, to me  
in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by  
John H. Earle of Greenville in the State of S.C.  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and  
release unto the said John H. Earle, all that piece of land aforesaid  
Greenville Township in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing  
fifteen and 4/10 acres, more or less, made up of several lots of parcels aforesaid as  
follows: No 1. containing twelve and 2/10 acres, more or less, being composed of three  
separate lots or tracts, but all embraced in a deed of the same, executed to me by  
N. A. Holte and others, being on or near the Air Line Rail Road, and the Public  
road generally known as the Boy's Bridge Road about 2 1/2 miles of the City  
of Greenville S.C. adjoining lands of John H. Brown, John H. Earle, J. G.  
Speagle & others,  
No 2. containing Seven & 4/10 acres, adjoining the above tract and  
comprising with it one tract, and originally composed of two separate  
lots or tracts but both embraced and described in a deed of the same  
executed to me by the said John H. Earle, on 29th October 1883.
