 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and  
 release unto the said A. B. Brooks Tilley a certain tract piece or parcel of land lying  
 and being situate in Greenville County in the State aforesaid on the  
 North side of Meadow Fork Creek, and runs as follows: Beginning on  
 a Willow st on the said creek at the mouth of a small branch and  
 is also the corner of tract No 2, and runs with the said branch to its  
 head, and from thence to a stone st on the side of an old road on  
 Robert Pitman's line; thence N. W. with said Robert Pitman's land  
 to a rock st on J. P. Pitman's land, and thence with J. P. Pitman's land  
 to the said Meadow Fork Creek to a stone st in said creek, thence  
 with the meanders down of said creek to the beginning Willow st.  
 Known as tract No 11 as set off by W. D. Southern, Jr. Ch. Tilley
