Deed of Survey

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Plaintiff, all that piece of land or tract of land containing
Eighty seven acres, more or less, situate, lying and being in Butler Township in the County
and State of Pennsylvania, on both sides of the road leading from Freeville City to Butler, and
being the following miles, bounded and bounded viz: Beginning at a stone 34 m. in distance
upwards North side of said road and running thence 11 m. E. 16° S. to a stone 34 m., thence 383 ft.
to a stone 34 m. South side of said road on W. line, thence with said line S 84° E. 20.20 ft.
west. Then 34 m. going N. on Rockey creek, thence down the creek to a stone 34 m., at the
N. E. corner of said 3.30 to a road in Broad, thence N 85° E. 5.53 to a stone 34 m. in dis-
tance 11.2 E. 16.9.0 to the beginning corner, adjoining lands of Benjamin Smith, W. B. Smith,
Green, and, Thence 110 ft. and 5 and 1/2 rods to the lands of Henry J. Elmer as survey


