Springs Township, and hath such Marks bounds &c as follows, viz: - Beginning on a stone 310, one Road to Bradleys, thence 8 1/2 E 92.25 to a Thinstone 310, thence E 17.00 to a Chestnut 310, down; thence N 20 W 119.75 to a stone 310, thence S 80 N E 4.50 to a stone 310; thence N 81 W 9.35 to a stone 310, thence S 14 W 18.75 to the beginning corner, bounded by lands of W.
