release unto the said J. M. Howard, all that certain piece, tract or land in County  
and State aforesaid, containing forty and one-half acres more or less,  
having the following lines and bounds; Beginning at a rock in creek  
at the corner of land of G. W. Holtclaw, and C. B. Jackson, thence along  
line of C. B. Jackson S 14 $\frac{1}{2}$  E Eighteen chains & twenty-five links (18.45) to stone  
in road, separating this land from land of A. C. Dickson, thence along said  
road S 72 $\frac{3}{4}$  W Twenty chains to stone in road, thence N 16 W Twenty-two  
chains and forty links (22.40) to stone at corner of G. W. Holtclaw's land,
