release unto the said Giles E. Purvis or his assigns tract pieces or parcels of
land in the County & State aforesaid and in Sabudia Township
or some small branches of the North Fork of Saluda River, being
a part of the land formerly owned by Odessa Cox and known as tract
No. 2 in the survey and division of the same made by W.W. Hunt
Surveyor, on the 10th day of September A.D. 1888. The following are the
miles and bounds of said tract. Beginning at a large pine on the
line of W.C. Goodwin Esq. Roads, and going N 88° E 26,300 chains to a stone;
thence N 88° E 32,430 chains to a pine 34, thence N 42° W 14,500 chains to a
stone 34, thence N 81° W 28,500 chains to a pine 34, thence N 58° W 4,500
