(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. N. Nesbit*, his heirs and assigns forever, all my right title and interest in the three several

tracts of land, hereinafter described all lying and being situated in the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina to wit: That tract of land known as the Skinner Tract "containing forty five $\frac{1}{2}$ (45 1/2) acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of Scipio Bryant, the Nesbit Tract" hereinafter described by Sparta L Jones, and the Bumble Tract, hereinafter described (2). That tract of land known as the Nesbit Tract "containing forty six and one half (46 1/2) acres, more or less, bounded by Emory River, the said Skinner Tract, Scipio Bryant's land, Harry Taylor's land and others (3rd). That tract of land known as a part of the Bumble Tract "containing one hundred and four $\frac{1}{4}$ (104) acres, more or less, bounded by the above named Skinner tract by lands of E. P. Jones, lands of A. C. Wood, lands of J. Black, lands of Harrison Bryant and lands of Scipio Bryant, all of which three tracts of land have been surveyed and described by E. P. Jones which are intended to be recorded with this conveyance. The following is a description of said three tracts of land the Skinner Tract, the Nesbit and the Bumble tract which have been surveyed by E. P. Jones and is intended to be recorded with this conveyance. The Skinner Tract is bounded by lines running as follows: Beginning on a stone in the old Rutherford Road where it crosses Emory River near Sparta L Jones mill, thence up said River at high water mark 33 rods to a maple tree, thence N 10 W 16 rods to a stone on by a stream, thence S 78 E 10.5 rods to a pine tree, thence S 20 E 11 rods to the said old Rutherford Road, which has been changed, thence down said old road 37 rods to the beginning corner (2nd). The Nesbit Tract is bounded by lines running as follows: Beginning on a maple on Taylors Branch, branch parallel of said Emory River, thence down said Taylors Branch 2 rods, thence a straight line to a stone on on said Emory River 13 rods, below the mouth of said Taylors Branch, thence up said Emory River 13 rods to a stone in River, thence S 38 E 16.5 rods to a stone 3 rods, thence S 37 E 9 rods to a white oak 3 m, thence S 55 E 3.25 rods to a maple 13 rods to beginning corner (3rd). The Bumble Tract is bounded by lines running as follows: Beginning at a stone in said Rutherford Road and running with the road as the line about 33.5 rods to a stone inside Rutherford Road, thence S 25 E 5 rods to a stone 3 rods to a stone 10 rods to a stone 3 rods, thence N 49 E 10.75 rods to a poplar 2 rods, thence S 25 E 8 rods to a stone 3 rods, thence N 55 E 11.10 rods to a stone 3 rods, thence S 60 E 8.7 rods to a stone 3 rods, thence N 25 E 11 rods to the beginning corner.
