adjoining the land of the Greenville Cotton Mills, and hath the following  
metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin at the South West corner  
of the lands of The Greenville Cotton Mills, and running S 69 $\frac{1}{4}$  E 150  
feet to an iron pin, thence S 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 40 feet, to an iron pin; thence N 69 $\frac{1}{4}$   
W 150 feet, to an iron pin on road; thence N 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 40 feet along said  
road to the beginning corner. Said land was to me devised  
by the heirs of the late W. A. McDaniel, dec'd;
