T. Spurlock Franklin Beattie and W. G. Muller, and I do hereby make, take and record the same in the Register of Deeds Office of Greenville County in Book C.C., page 604 being the lot of land known as the Main lot and running from Lot No. 4 along the line of the lot bounded by W.
