KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, William W. Gilbreath, of the City and County of Greenville  
 in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum  
 of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3000.00) Dollars to me in hand paid at  
 and before the sealing of these presents by Daniel H. Bill and James A. Bill  
 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and  
 release unto the said Daniel H. Bill and James A. Bill all that piece  
 of land or part of land situate, lying and being at the corner of Main  
 and North Streets, in Ward No 1 in the City of Greenville and  
 the County and State aforesaid; Beginning at the corner of said  
 Main and North Streets and running thence along Main Street  
 in an almost southerly direction fifty (50) feet to a point on  
 said Main Street to the corner of another lot of mine, thence in an  
 almost northerly direction, the line of my said lot One  
 foot in at northerly direction to a point on the south side of  
 North Street; thence generally east and along said North Street  
 One Hundred and Twenty (120) feet to the beginning. It is  
 the intention of the parties to this deed to convey with the said  
 Daniel H. Bill and James A. Bill Thirty (30) feet on Main Street  
 beginning at the corner of Main and North Streets One Hundred  
 and Twenty (120) feet back. It is to pay two thirds to the said  
 Daniel H. Bill and the remaining one third to the said  
 James A. Bill.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in any  
 wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said

Daniel H. Bill and James A. Bill and their Heirs and Assigns forever.  
 It is to pay two thirds to Daniel H. Bill and his heirs and assigns  
 forever, and the remaining one third to James A. Bill and his  
 heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, Daniel H. Bill and James A. Bill, their  
 Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever  
 defend all and singular the said premises unto the said

Heirs and Assigns, against all and every person whomsoever lawfully  
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
