

 acres more or less, and hath such marks bounds, distances,
 as follows: Beginning on a P. O. 340, thence S 73 $\frac{1}{4}$ W 8, 30 to a
 stone 340, thence S 71 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 5, 00 to a Peach tree 340, thence S 77 $\frac{1}{2}$
