From this line thence southwardly 268.20 ft to a stake 4 m. in the said Gap Creek road. Thence with said road S 84 W 4.35 ft to a stake 4 m. in the said Gap Creek road. Thence with said road S 84 W 4.000 ft to a small sapling 34 m. on the west side of said road. Thence with said road S 35 E 4.446 ft to the beginning stone and pine and bounded on the north by lands of Dr. G. Beattie, on the west by lands of said Guest and J. R.
