 a line parallel to the side of McBee St, 130 ft, to a point on the rear line of
 my lot, thence along said rear line 8 ft to a line of McBee St, thence
 Subsidiarily along present lot line to McBee St, 130 ft, to the beginning
 & containing 650 sq. feet.
