A. Harvey of said County and State, all that portion or tract of land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid and on waters of South Tyger River and known as a part of the Charles Wood tract, and bounded by lands of Manly Pitt, Benj Holly, Callemann and others, and containing Sixty three acres, more or less and being a portion of One Hundred and forty six acres bought from S. C. Dickson by Elias Raney the 27th Nov 1884. For further description see Plat made by Johnson & S. S. here with attached.

Begins, going on a stone and running thence N 17 W 19, 40° to a red oak 37' thence S 62 W 3, 88' to a stone, thence N 33 W 10, 80' to a stone 34, thence S 43 W 6 26' to red oak (dead) thence S 41 R 11, 80' to a double bowwood, thence N 48 W 8 00' to a Spanish oak 34 on a branch, thence up the said branch with the proceedings of the branch about 36, 00' to a Holly at the head of the branch, thence the dividing line that was run the first day of Sept 1884, dividing the land formerly Elias and James A. Raney and set off to Wm S. Raney.
