Willis (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William D. Willis all that piece of land and tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, containing therein acres, more or less and lying on the East side of the State Road, and having the following metes and bounds, Beginning at a stake of said Road running N 39° 16' E, to rock N 44° E 13.60 chs, to rock, &c, more in said State road, to the beginning corner and being the same tract of land so described to myself and John C. Singleton by Thomas Edwards by Deed bearing date the 23rd day of October 1880, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds Conveyance of said County in Vol. 12 page 494, and being same conveyed to me by J. P. Thresher Master by Deed bearing date the 5th day of December 1887, and recorded in said office in Vol. 17 page 659, and bounded by lands of Julia Edwards, A. B. Styles, and said William D. Willis.
