 tract of land lying and being situated in Greenville County in
 State aforesaid on Broad River containing sixteen acres
 more or less and having a front of one hundred feet as follows:
 Beginning at a stone 3x4 in the bank of said Broad River
 at the mouth of Big Creek and running thence up the said river to a
 stone 3x4 on said Big Creek being thence 125 ft for 10.80 to a point
 where 80 ft from the same 16.25 ft 10.28 to a stone 3x4 in the bank of the
 creek, thence down the prong of the said creek to the beginning corner
 bounded by lands of Mr. William H. Lennard and others.
