 having and excepting so much thereof as has been conveyed to me by said  
 parties as my share of her estate. The following is a description of the  
 real estate hereby intended to be conveyed, a part of tract number 3 of  
 James H Cleveland deceased estate in Cleveland Township,  
 Beginning at the mouth of Dixie Mingo Creek branch on Middle fork of  
 Saluda River, thence up said branch and with its meanderings to the
