 of our right to the interest and estate, whether under the will of Noel
 Waddell deceased to children or heirs at law of Sarah A. Jenkins or other-
 wise, of in or to that tract of land situate lying and being in
 the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, lying on the west
 side of the road leading from the City of Greenville in the State of South
 Carolina about seven miles from the former place to Sandy Hat bounded
