and before the sealing of these presents by my said wife *Anna Green* (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

*Anna Green* all that piece of land and tract of land situate lying and being in *Broad Branch* in the County of *Greenville* aforesaid containing a adjoining a corner of *W. J. Barnes* Jacob Barnes's *B. F. Goodlett* and others certain *acres* of fifty eight and one acre more or less lying part of *the Callicoon* and *Rocky* place assigned to me by *W. J. Barnes* his wife and being the tract of land wherein I now live also all right title and interest in all that piece of land and tract of land situate lying and being in *Pine Hill* in *Greenville* and *Plants* aforesaid containing one hundred and eighty acres more or less being the portion of the inheritance of my father and mother deceased set off to *John* and *Children* and *now* sold at *Public Sale* the same to be held and enjoyed by his *Heirs* during the term or period of her natural life or widowhood and at her death to *Mary* then in fee simple to my son *Charles Adda Green* *Anna Green* her son *John*, and to their heirs.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said *Anna Green* during her life or widowhood after her death or marriage to my son *Charles Adda Green* and his wife *Anna Green*, and then in *trust* for her *Heirs*, and *then* in *trust* for her *Heirs*, subject however to my right to use, occupy and enjoy both of said tracts of land for and during the time of my natural life time and to devolve my other use and enjoyment thereof to my *Heirs* for and during the time of my life time.
